The **Coro Latinoamericano - Pittsburgh (Latin American Choir - Pittsburgh)** and guest performers, conducted by **Dr. Meredith Armbrust**, will perform a selection of some of the most popular Latin American songs, including **Adelita** (Mexico), **Cachita** and **Guajira Guantanamera** (Cuba), **Prendeme la Vela** (Colombia), and other rhythmic pearls of Latin American culture.

The concert will close with the exhilarating **Danza Final** by Alberto Ginastera and **Mambo** by Leonard Bernstein, with a grand finale by Coro Latinoamericano and the Pittsburgh Youth Chamber Orchestra joining together to perform **America** from West Side story and **Brazil**.
