**About PYCO** 

The Pittsburgh Youth Concert Orchestra was founded in 2006 by Pablo Ardiles, who is enjoying his 11th year as PYCO Artistic Director. What began as a youth chamber orchestra has grown to a **full symphonic orchestra** with the addition of various ensembles, giving young musicians a variety of opportunities to pursue their love of musical performance.

PYCO performs several concerts per year throughout the Pittsburgh area. We offer a 1-week **orchestra day camp** during the summer. The camp is open to all current members as well as interested students who want to explore orchestral and ensemble playing.

Every 3 years we give students the opportunity to perform abroad in an **international concert tour**. In July 2012 we performed in Salzburg, Vienna and Prague, and in July 2015 we performed in London, Stratford-upon-Avon and Paris. Our next tour is scheduled for July 2018, with concerts in Rome, Florence, and Venice.

PYCO offers ensembles for **strings, woodwinds, brass, percussion, piano, and harp**. Membership is by audition or at the recommendation of the ensemble directors.

Auditions for admittance into PYCO or any PYCO ensemble for the 2016 – 2017 season will be on Sunday, June 5, 2016 from 12 pm to 7 pm. We also offer year-round auditions by appointment.

#### **PYCO Ensembles**

**PYCO Orchestra:** Conducted by PYCO Artistic Director, Pablo Ardiles, membership in this division is reserved for outstanding string, winds, brass & percussion players whose technical level is highly advanced, who show strong musicianship, and who are capable of the discipline and commitment necessary to perform in one of Pittsburgh's premier youth orchestras. **Repertoire is at college/professional level**. The orchestra accepts students in grades 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, although musicians may remain beyond high school.

**Chamber Brass:** This program provides a unique opportunity for talented brass players in grades 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> to perform exciting and **challenging music for brass ensemble**, under the direction of Phil VanOuse and Rick Murrell.

**Chamber Strings:** Under the direction of Younga Reitz, this program is designed to advance the level of string players in grades 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> in preparation for the more demanding repertoire in PYCO.

Jr. Strings: Under the direction of Joyce Wohlgemuth, this program is designed to build solid, fundamental rhythmic and orchestral skills and improved sight-reading abilities in a non-competitive, relaxed, supportive and fun environment for string students in grades 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>.

**Jr. Wind Ensemble:** Comprised of woodwinds, brass and percussion players in grades 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, this program is designed to inspire students through challenging and engaging wind ensemble music in a fun and nurturing environment.

In addition, we offer the unique opportunity for each section of the wind ensemble to be featured as independent groups, performing as **Jr. Woodwinds** (Linda Granite, director), **Jr. Brass** (Phil VanOuse, director) and **Jr. Percussion** (Amy Stubbs, director).
