Consult with your teacher for the best music selection for your recording. Alternatively you can contact PYCO to schedule a placement audition. Students who are members of the PYCO Orchestra or any PYCO Ensemble do not need to submit a recording or request a placement audition.

Orchestra Level Participation

- Qualified students may perform in the Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced orchestra level(s).
- Placement will be determined at the discretion of the ensemble directors.
- All orchestra levels will perform in the concert at the end of the week for family and friends.

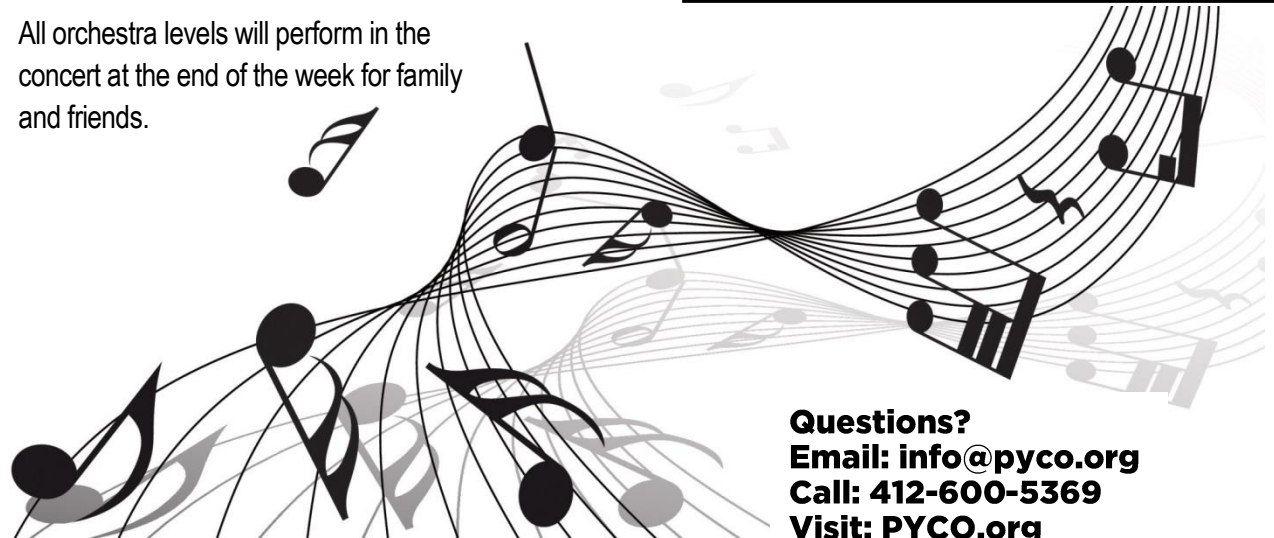
